The Chancellor recommends the Governing Board authorize the Chancellor or designee to execute a/an Amendment to Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Arizona Department of Corrections, Rehabilitation and Reentry (ADCRR) for the purpose of delivering educational programs by the College's Workforce Development Department to adult inmates at the Arizona State Prison Complex - Tucson for a three year term from July 1, 2026 to June 30, 2029 and authorize the Chancellor or designee to take any action or execute any other agreement necessary to accomplish the purposes of the agreement as may be limited by the Chancellor's or designee previously authorized signature authority.
