The Governing Board delegates to the Chancellor or designee the authority and responsibility of protecting the Pima Community College (“College”) environment and the health and safety of its students, employees, contractors, and visitors.

Accordingly, the College shall:

1. Offer appropriate environmental health and safety services, programs, and activities to help the College meet its formal obligations and responsibilities for protecting the environment and the health and safety of its students, employees, contractors, and visitors;
2. Provide programs, training, and equipment to reduce risk through safety and

loss control activities

3. Establish environmental, health, and safety compliance and ensure regulations, with internal policies and external regulatory agencies are met. Act as a liaison for communication between the College and the agencies.
4. Maintain a safe, healthy, and sanitary learning and working environment.
