Course Enrollment: POS204, Intro to Comparative Politics, 3 cr. (July 8 to Aug. 9) AND/OR POS196, Independent Study in Political Science, 3 cr. (July 20-31) (*Available seats 16; minimum 10*)

Study Abroad Program Fee: \$3,500
includes round-trip airfare between Phoenix and Berlin, local transportation in Germany, lodging (shared hostel rooms), breakfasts and most group activities. This fee does not include Pima tuition, lunches, dinners, transportation between Tucson and Phoenix, travel insurance, passport fee, some entrance fees, etc.

Non-refundable \$200 deposit is due upon admission to the program. The deposit will be applied to the program fee.

Study Abroad program fee is due March 31, 2024.

Estimated meals not in program: \$400

Estimated Travel Insurance: \$100 (*not required but strongly recommended*)

Estimated Tucson-Phoenix transportation cost: \$100

Tuesday, July 23, 2024	Lecture in the morning; meet and greet with local university students
Wednesday, July 24, 2024	Lecture in the morning; cultural activity in the afternoon
Thursday, July 25, 2024	Class in the morning, cultural activity in the afternoon
Friday, July 26, 2024	Bus to Szczecin, Poland; The National Museum in Szczecin in the morning; Pomeranian Dukes' Castle in the afternoon
Saturday, July 27, 2024	Jewish Museum Berlin in the morning; German Parliament visit and Reichstagsgebäude in the afternoon
Sunday, July 28, 2024	Train to Oranienburg; Sachsenhausen Memorial and Museum; return to Berlin in the afternoon
Monday, July 29, 2024	Class and lecture in the morning; cultural activity in the afternoon
